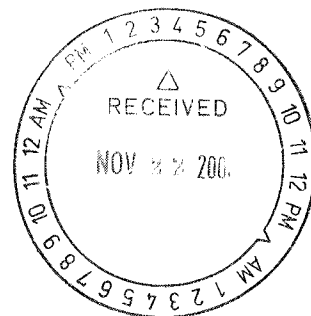

ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS  
FROM AND TO MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2120-A

On August 22, 2005, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Cinergy Marketing & Trading, LP (Cinergy) in DOE/FE Order No. 2120 (Order 2120) (2 FE ¶71,172) to import and export up to a combined total of 500 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from and to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2005, and extending through October 31, 2007.

On October 24, 2006, DOE was notified that Cinergy had changed its name to Fortis Energy Marketing & Trading, GP, and as a result, no longer needs the current authorization. Cinergy has requested that DOE vacate Order 2120.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 2120, authorizing the import and export of natural gas from and to Mexico, is hereby vacated.
