Dear Senator Pryor,

I respect that you have adopted a cautious position on the issue of accelerating and expanding the permitting process for Liquid Natural Gas (LNG) exports. However, because our state has become a key player in natural gas development and global demand for LNG has grown, I urge you to join with many of your colleagues in the Arkansas congressional delegation and in other energy producing states and lend your full support to moving LNG export forward.

International developments have highlighted the need for our nation to responsibly develop vast natural gas resources to supply our allies abroad and to generate sustainable economic growth at home. The Fayetteville Shale is a proven natural gas producer and operations here could grow and generate broad economic benefits if LNG export opportunities are expedited.
