A block reservation for 50 rooms is available until June 10, 2022. Please access the hotel website and use the promotional code NO145482 when booking a room.




The <u>Bergen Airport</u> is located approx. 16 kilometers by bus or taxi from Bergen city center. Two less expensive alternatives to taxis are the <u>Airport Express Bus</u> or the <u>tram (light rail)</u>. The express bus departs the airport every 30 minutes and has it its end station outside the Radisson Blue hotel. Transit time is about 30 minutes. The light rail departs the airport every 5-8 minutes and has a transit time to the city center of about 45 minutes, with a 10 minutes walk from the end station to the hotel. Express bus fare is 139 NOK, light rail fare is 40 NOK.



The Radisson Blu Royal Hotel, Bergen is nestled next to <u>Bryggen</u>, a series of Hanseatic heritage commercial buildings lining up the eastern side of the Vågen harbour. Bryggen is one of Norway's most popular attractions and has been on the UNESCO list for World Cultural Heritage sites since 1979.


Another tourist attraction in Bergen is <u>Fløibanen</u>, a furnicular (cable railway) that takes you from the city centre to the top of a hill 320 m above the city, with a nice stroll back to the city.



Site Visit

The site visit will take place Wednesday June 29 to the <u>Northern Lights</u> construction site, located at Kollsnes, approximately 50 km north of Bergen. It is a nice bus ride along the outer islands of the Norwegian west coast. A bus will leave from outside the Radisson Blu Royal Hotel at 09:00 am (meet no later than 08:45 am) and arrive at Northern Lights approximately 10:00 am. After a tour of the site (inside the bus) the participants will be divided in three groups, which in turn will 1) get an introduction to Northern Lights Joint Venture (NL JV), market situation for industries incl. future prospects and Direct Air Capture (DAC) plans at NL JV; 2) get general information on the project, activities at receiving station, the subsurface with storage capacity and safety, pipeline, and ships; and 3) be taken to a view point over the whole site, where pictures will be allowed. Bus will return to Bergen at round 13:00. Food and beverages for lunch will be handed out before departure from Kollsnes.

NOTE: There is a limit of 80 participants for the site visit. First come will be first served.



SUMMARY
