UPDATE OF THE CSLF PROJECTS INTERACTION AND REVIEW TEAM'S ACTIVITIES

Note by the Secretariat

Background

The creation of a new Project Initiation and Review Panel (PIRP) was proposed at the meeting of the Technical Group in Melbourne, Australia on 15 September 2004. The functions of the proposed PIRP were to assess projects proposed for recognition by the CSLF and to review the CSLF project portfolio to identify synergies and gaps that would then act as input for any future revisions to the CSLF Technology Roadmap. The European Commission assembled an ad-hoc panel of Technical Group delegates to produce a document describing the proposed PIRP and how it related to Policy Group functions and responsibilities. The ad-hoc panel's report was presented at the meeting of the Technical Group in Oviedo, Spain on 30 April 2005. The document was not accepted at that time and was subsequently revised and reintroduced at the meeting of the Technical Group in Berlin, Germany, on 27 September 2005 under a new title, the Projects Interaction and Review Team (PIRT). The PIRT proposal received approval by both the Technical and Policy Groups at the Berlin meeting. The PIRT Core Group held teleconferences In January and February 2006 to develop recommendations regarding PIRT organization and activities. This document is a status report.

Action Requested

Technical Group delegates are requested to consider the status report of the CSLF Projects Interaction and Review Team.
