

Workshop on CCUS for Energy Intensive Industries (EIs)

Thursday, November 7, 2019, in Chatou, Paris, France

This workshop is being co-hosted by the CSLF Technical Group and France's Club CO₂, and will complement the final report of the CSLF Task Force on CCUS for EIs.

The CCUS and EIs workshop will be a half-day initiative to present the CSLF Task Force final report, a result of a collaborative effort shared by representatives of a large panel of EIs. This document considers production of steel, cement, chemicals, refining, hydrogen, natural gas, heavy oil, fertilizers, and waste-to-energy.

This report:

- covers the role of EIs in current and future global and regional economics,
- establishes what could be the anticipated role of CCUS to reduce CO₂ emissions,
- suggests what would be the roles of the different types of stakeholders (among which the EIs themselves, the governments the end use consumers...),
- opens the discussion on how interactions between the different sectors of the EIs can contribute to the development of CCUS.

These points will be covered during this workshop and will be the backbone of its agenda. The aim is to share views on the conditions of the development of CCUS which can result in an acceleration of the development of CCUS in EIs.
