Summary of Consensus Reached

- Schedule for 2011 Technology Roadmap.
 - Agreed, update limited to refreshing country profiles and project activity [Secretariat called for updates by May, 2011]
 - Major effort directed 2012 version – to incorporate findings of Taskforce to Assess Progress on Technical Issues affecting CCS
- After extensive review: PIRT agree on terminating Technology Readiness Level analysis activity.
- Consensus reached to recommend Wandoan Project for CSLF-recognition to Technical Group in Edmonton (May)

OUTCOMES (1)

Procedural matters

- Agreed to remove *Taskforce to Assess Progress on Technical Issues affecting CCS* from PIRT – report to TG
- Will re-examine CSLF Gaps Analysis Checklist as used for Project Submission. Aim to simplify.
- Discussed technical presentations to the PIRT for CSLF project recognition – reaffirming the PIRT role in recommending projects to the TG

OUTCOMES (2)

Recommendations to TG that the :

- Jänschwalde Project (Germany/EU) and
- Zero Emission Porto Tolle [ZEPT] (Italy/ EU)

meet criteria for CSLF-project recognition.

Other matters

- At least two additional projects for CSLF recognition are anticipated for consideration at the September Ministerial meeting
- Discussion of possible future workshop topics – based on lessons learned. Knowledge sharing and capacity building being key attributes for CSLF. Support to be determined.
