Toyako commitment for the launch of 20 largescale CCS demonstration by 2010 reaffirmed in the G8 Summit of l'Aquila





G8 Leaders will act "to accelerate the design of policies, regulatory frameworks and incentive schemes focused on the development and deployment of CCS technology"





G8 Leaders will act "to encourage greater involvement of developing countries by promoting collaboration and knowledge diffusion also through IEA regional roundtables"





G8 Leaders will act "to identify investment needs and overcome obstacles, including potential innovative partnership with multilateral financial institutions"





G8 Leaders will act "to identify sources of financing for CCS demonstration projects"





G8 Leaders "invite the IEA together with the CSLF to report on and further develop technology roadmaps and to work with the private sector to accelerate the construction and operation of demonstration projects"





G8 Leaders invite the new Global Carbon Capture and Storage Institute "to actively coopertae with the ongoing activities by IEA and CSLF to ensure that these efforts are mutually reinforcing"
