Rome Meeting January 2004

- Policy Group discussed the Draft Guidelines for Involvement of Stakeholders
- > Agreed that stakeholder involvement was critical and should be an integral part
- Working group established to propose guidelines to the Policy Group for agreement
- Working group tasked with identifying the best path forward to ensure that stakeholder involvement is an integral part of the CSLF



Stakeholder Register

- The register is a first step mechanism to engage a diverse/ broad range of stakeholders
- Primary focus should be on information dissemination and outreach
- Stakeholders may nominate to be part of the register through their CSLF member
- CSLF Secretariat responsible for administration of the register
- Also anticipate individual domestic registers in operation



Regular Meetings

- Important to schedule regular CSLF stakeholder meetings to coincide with the timing of CSLF Ministerial meetings (approximately every two years)
- This would provide an opportunity for the CSLF to report back to stakeholders on progress of its work and milestones achieved
- It also provides for a broad spectrum and a growing number of stakeholders over time

Comments from other countries were incorporated into the document

- Proposed in London that the CSLF establish two reference panels – NGOs and Industry
- Concept of these reference groups received support at the London workshop
- Offers stakeholders the opportunity to add value on specific questions not addressed in other fora



Recommendations

- CSLF members support the CSLF concept paper
- CSLF members support establishment of a constructive stakeholder dialogue on CCS
- CSLF members support the inclusion of a broad range of stakeholders
- Establish a stakeholder register
- Schedule stakeholder review conference to coincide with CSLF Ministerial meetings
