

### CO<sub>2</sub>GeoNet celebrates its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary as a legal entity in 2018!





- Created as a EU FP6 Network of Excellence in 2004
- ✓ Became an **Association** under French law in 2008
- ✓ With IFPEN as renewed member, the Association now comprises 29 research institutes from 21 countries

#### CO<sub>2</sub>GeoNet mission



- Being the independent scientific voice of Europe on CO<sub>2</sub> geological storage to build trust in CO<sub>2</sub> geological storage and support wide-scale CCS implementation by executing activities on:
  - Joint research
  - Scientific advice
  - Training
  - Information and communication

#### CO<sub>2</sub>GeoNet actions



- CO<sub>2</sub>GeoNet uses the multidisciplinary expertise of it's Members to advance the science supporting CCS.
- Members undertake joint research on geological storage of CO<sub>2</sub>, e.g. through ENOS and ECOBASE.
- Focus on technical geoscientific and social aspects of CO<sub>2</sub> storage:
  - Research outcomes (peer reviewed papers, storage site assessments, monitoring technologies/techniques, dynamic site models.....)
  - Provide impartial, evidence-based scientific advice
- Collaborate with international organisations such as CSLF and IEAGHG (e.g. COP23 side events)

#### Update since Abu Dhabi, 4 Dec 2017 (I)



#### European RTD policy related actions:

- Advising on and monitoring of CCS/CCU SET Plan (IWG), e.g. on storage atlas and storage appraisal
- Contributed to the consultation on the Innovation Fund
- Informing member states on importance of storage pilots in H2020 work programme 2018-2020
- Defining the scope of the 9<sup>th</sup> EU RTD Framework Programme (EERA Workshop on 19 April)
- Embedding EU research in the global research agenda, e.g. define possible role of the Association in MI#3

#### Update since Abu Dhabi, 4 Dec 2017 (II)



- CO<sub>2</sub>GeoNet cherishes the recognition by CSLF as an Allied Organization
  - Regional Stakeholder intervention
  - CSLF activities, e.g. BECCS report
  - Input to CSLF Meetings and Task forces
- Invite CSLF to provide a representative for the CO<sub>2</sub>GeoNet Advisory Committee
  - AC Meeting during lunch time tomorrow (24 April)
- ENOS project, a CO<sub>2</sub>GeoNet initiative, as candidate Recognized CSLF Project
