- Working Groups on Covering Gaps in Knowledge
 - 1. Change name to "Task Force on Addressing Technical Issues"; projects encounter and address technical issues, not scientific gaps
 - 2. Take a pro-active stance towards projects, even if at pilot scale, that address issues not addressed by any other CSLF-recognized project, and invite them to join (e.g., CO₂ storage in basalts in Iceland and US)
 - 3. Need for guidelines about how a project should proceed, as opposed to standards or regulations
 - 4. Organize a workshop on CO₂ transportation, the Cinderella of CCS
