Financing CCUS Task Force

- Focus is on understanding commercial-scale financing needs.
- Activities include workshops, expert dialogs and reports.

Key findings so far:

- 1. CCUS can be cost competitive with other low-carbon technologies.
- 2. Multiple types of incentives are needed.
- 3. Regulatory frameworks are necessary.
- 4. Demonstrations are needed for financial community confidence.
- 5. Demonstrations are key opportunities for international collaborations in all areas of CCUS and must receive recognition and support broadly.
