- Identify and review new and updated existing standards for geological CO₂ storage and monitoring on an annual basis
- Identify and review new and updated existing guidelines for communication with and engagement of involved communities and regulators on an annual basis.
- Identify shortcomings and/or weaknesses in standards/guidelines
- ➤ Keep track of the work within Communicate findings to the ISO, where a CCS working group that has been established
- Produce annual summaries of new as well as updated standards, guidelines and best practice documents regarding geological storage of CO₂ and monitoring of CO₂ sites.
- Follow the work of other task forces related to CO2 storage, e.g.
 - Task Force on Action Plan#7 Technical Challenges for Conversion of CO₂-EOR to CCS (Canada).
 - Task Force on Action Plan#1 Technology Gap Closure (Australia)
