2013 CSLF TRM



- It was decided in Bergen to make a new TRM in time for the Ministerial
- It should be a major revision, and much shorter with emphasis on the most important messages to Ministers and other Politicians
- A Steering Committee lead by TG Chair, with Vice-Chairs, TF leaders and Secretariat should be established.
- The SC should agree on a scope and outline for the TRM
- TG Chair was encouraged to contact IEA, Paris, to discuss collaboration in developing road maps
- The Scoping paper is in the electronic TG book

Meeting with IEA



- Contact with IEA through Stefan
- TG Chair met with Ellina Levina in Paris, October 12
- Very positive approach for collaboration
- IEA focus mainly on policy, regulatory issues, legal, public acceptance etc.
- Very interested in technical input from us
- IEA has established an Advisory Board; SINTEF participates, we can discuss with them
- Tony Surridge also member of AB
- Stakeholder meetings in Kyoto and Paris





- RCN applied for, and received support from Ministry of Petroleum and Energy to hire a consultant
- Offer from SINTEF accepted, contract after TG meeting
- Three well qualified SINTEF researchers will work with Lars Ingolf Eide editor of the TRM
- The TG Steering Committee (SC) will be consulted several times during the process

Proposed time schedule



- Status and assessment, draft: December 10.
 - Based on GCCSI, Climit, EU ZEP etc.
 - One week consultation with the SC Contact with IEA
- Define priorities for R,D&D activities, draft list, not detailed: First week of January
 - One week consultation with the SC. Possible contact with IEA
- Continued work with text for prioritized activities
 - Draft for consultation with SC, telecon if needed: End of February
 - Draft to the TG meeting in Italy (not one month in advance!)
 - Have a full day meeting with SC in Italy, just before TG
