Five day meeting, including a site visit to SaskPower's Boundary Dam CCS Project and CO₂ Capture Test Facility





Boundary Dam CCS Project

- World's first postcombustion coalfired CCS project
- 90% CO₂ capture
 on a 120-MW unit
- One million tonnes of CO₂ captured per year
- CO₂ sold for EOR





SaskPower CCS Test Facility

- Located at Shand
 Power Plant
- Designed to provide a robust evaluation of amine-based post-combustion CO₂ Capture technologies





SaskPower CCS Test Facility

- Facility dedicated in June 2015
- We were there for the dedication event!


