Natural Gas Supply/Demand Notice of Inquiry

The highest and best use of natural gas is in residential and petrochemical applications. AEO's forecasts of greatly increased natural gas use to generate electricity are unrealistic and not going to be realized due to high gas prices, and need to be revised downward. Efforts should be concentrated on deploying available technologies to produce substitute natural gas from Kentucky coal, via a "Manhattan Project" sense of urgency.
