In DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 521 (Order 521), issued

July 26, 1991, UTRADE Gas Company was authorized to export up to

146 Bcf of natural gas to Mexico (1 FE Para. 70,469). Also, on

December 26, 1991, this company was authorized in DOE/FE Opinion

and Order No. 562 (Order 562) to import up to 150 Bcf of natural

gas from Canada (1 FE Para. 70,516). Each authorization was granted

for a period of two years beginning on the date of the first

delivery. To the present date, neither exports nor imports have

occurred under these authorizations. On July 20, 1993, the

Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy was informed

that UTRADE Gas Company changed its name to MidCon Texas Gas

Services Corp. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural

Gas Act, Orders 521 and 562 are amended to reflect the name

change by substituting MidCon Texas Gas Services Corp. for UTRADE

Gas Company as the exporter and importer of the natural gas.
