ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 602-B

BridgeGas Company, as successor to BridgeGas U.S.A. Inc., is currently authorized to export up to 98.55 Bcf of natural gas to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on the date of the first export delivery. Exports have not yet commenced under this authorization. These exports were originally authorized in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 6021/ (Order 602), issued April 17, 1992, as amended by DOE/FE Order No. 602-A2/ (Order 602-A), issued July 11, 1994.

On August 22, 1994, Teco Gas Marketing Company (Teco) filed a second application to further amend Order 602 to reflect the change in company name as a result of the acquisition of BridgeGas U.S.A. Inc. by Teco Pipeline Company (Teco Pipeline) on February 1, 1994. Teco is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Teco Pipeline. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas

Act, the export authorization conferred by DOE/FE Opinion and Order Nos. 602 and 602-A is again amended by substituting Teco Gas Marketing Company for BridgeGas Company as the exporter of the natural gas.
