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ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT AND  
EXPORT NATURAL GAS, INCLUDING LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 627-A

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In DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 627 (Order 627), issued June 5, 1992, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted Unigas Corporation (Unigas) blanket authorization to import and export up to 200 Bcf of natural gas, including liquefied natural gas (LNG), from and to Canada, Mexico and other countries (See 1 FE 70,590). The term of the

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authorization is for two years beginning on the date of the initial import or export, whichever occurred first. Exports of natural gas under this authorization commenced December 19, 1992, and imports commenced November 1, 1993. Thus, Order 627 will remain in effect through December 18, 1994.

On February 17, 1994, Unigas filed an application to amend Order 627 because the corporation changed its name to Westcoast Gas Services Inc., effective November 1, 1993. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 627 is

amended to reflect the name change by substituting Westcoast Gas

Services Inc. as the importer and exporter of the natural gas and  
LNG.
