ORDER TRANSFERRING AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT
AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 789-A

In DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 789 (Order 789)1/, issued

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March 30, 1993, Enron Gas Marketing Canada Inc. (EGMC) was granted blanket authorization to import up to 900 Bcf of natural gas and export up to 900 Bcf of natural gas from and to Canada. The term of the authorization is for two years beginning on the date of the initial import or export delivery, whichever occurs first. Deliveries have not yet begun under Order 789. On June 17, 1994, the Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy was notified that EGMC had merged with Enron Gas Liquids Canada, Ltd. to form a corporation known as Enron Gas Services Canada Corp. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization granted in Order 789 is

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transferred from Enron Gas Marketing Canada Inc. to Enron Gas Services Canada Corp., effective on the date of this Order.
