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ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS  
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 808-A

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In DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 808 (Order 808), issued June 8, 1993, Inland Natural Gas Marketing Ltd. (INGM), a British Columbia, Canada corporation with its principal place of business in Vancouver, British Columbia, is authorized to import and export natural gas from and to Canada. Specifically, INGM is authorized to import up to 50 Bcf of gas and to export up to 50 Bcf of gas over a period of two years beginning on the date of the initial import or export, whichever occurs first.<sup>1/</sup> INGM

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began importing gas into the United States on November 6, 1993, and the two-year term, therefore, extends through November 5, 1995.

On November 25, 1994, INGM informed the Department of Energy that its name was changed to Inland Pacific Energy Services Ltd.,

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effective May 13, 1994. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 808 is amended by substituting Inland Pacific Energy Services Ltd. for Inland Natural Gas Marketing Ltd. as the importer and exporter of the natural gas.
