ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 829-A

In DOE/FE Order No. 829 (Order 829) issued August 3, 1993, Development Associates, Inc. (Development), a corporation organized in the State of Washington and located in Spokane, Washington, is authorized to import natural gas from Canada. Specifically, Development has authority to import up to 48 Bcf of natural gas over a two-year term beginning on the date of the first delivery.^{1/} Imports of gas began August 3, 1993, and the two-year term, therefore, extends through August 2, 1995.

On October 11, 1994, Development informed the Department of Energy that its name was changed to Inland Pacific Energy Services Corp., effective June 1, 1994. Accordingly, pursuant to

section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 829 is amended by substituting Inland Pacific Energy Services Corp. for Development Associates, Inc. as the importer of the natural gas.
