ORDER TERMINATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 894-A

On December 17, 1993, the Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy (DOE/FE) granted blanket authorization to CanStates Petroleum Marketing (CanStates) in DOE/FE Order No. 894 (Order 894)^{1/} to import up to 180 Bcf of natural gas from

Canada over a two-year term beginning on the date of the first delivery. Imports have not yet commenced under this order. On February 18, 1994, Pan Candian Petroleum Limited (Pan Canadian) filed an application with DOE/FE to terminate this import authorization because the name and all business assets of CanStates have been sold to Pan Canadian, effective February 1, 1994. Because Pan Canadian currently has a blanket authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada, granted in

DOE/FE Order No. 611-A,2/ the CanStates authorization in Order
