ORDER TECHNICALLY AMENDING NATURAL GAS IMPORT AUTHORIZATION

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 909-A

On January 5, 1994, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 909 (Order 909) which granted Tenaska Gas Co. and Tenaska Washington Partners II, L.P. (jointly, the Applicants) authorization to import from Canada up to 14,311 MMBtu per day of natural gas over a period of 20 years. Order 909 inadvertently omitted authorization to import additional quantities of gas to reimburse Northwest Pipeline Corporation for fuel required in providing transportation services to the Applicants from Sumas Washington, the point of delivery into the United States. Accordingly, the first sentence of Ordering Paragraph A in Order 909 is revised to read: "Tenaska Gas Co. and Tenaska Washington Partners II, L.P. (jointly, the Applicants) are authorized to import from Canada up to 14,311 MMBtu (approximately 14,311 Mcf) per day of natural gas

purchased from Husky Gas Marketing, Inc. (Husky), plus such additional quantities as may be required to reimburse Northwest Pipeline Company for fuel used in rendering its transportation services."
