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ORDER TRANSFERRING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 925-A

On March 18, 1994, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Arkla Energy Marketing, Inc. (Arkla) in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 925 (Order 925) to import up to 146 Bcf of natural gas from Canada and Mexico, and to export up to 146 Bcf of natural gas to Canada and Mexico.^{1/} The term of the authorization is for a period of two years beginning on the date of the first import or export delivery, whichever occurs first. Neither imports nor exports have commenced under this order.

On December 13, 1994, as amended December 20, 1994, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that, because of a corporate restructuring, Arkla no longer exists and the imports and exports of natural gas authorized under Order 925 will be performed by a different corporation, NorAm Energy Services, Inc., beginning January 1, 1995. Accordingly, pursuant to

section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization

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granted in Order 925 is transferred from Arkla Energy Marketing, Inc. to NorAm Energy Services, Inc., effective January 1, 1995.
