ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 293-B


American Central Gas Marketing Company (American Central) is currently authorized in DOE/ERA Opinion and Order No. 293 (Order 293) to import up to 73 Bcf and to export up to 73 Bcf of natural gas from and to Canada over a period of two years.^{1/} Imports have not yet begun under this authorization. In a letter dated August 22, 1995, American Central Gas Companies, Inc., the parent company of American Central, requested that the Department of Energy terminate American Central's authorization effective August 1, 1995.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas granted in
