ORDER AMENDING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATIONS
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 349-A

Northridge Petroleum Marketing, Inc. (NPMI) is authorized by DOE/FE Order No. 349, FE 70,257, to import, and subsequently to export, up to 15,000 Mcf per day of natural gas from and to Canada as part of a transportation arrangement with Union Gas Limited. The import/export authorization does not result in a net import of foreign gas into the U.S. or a net export of U.S. produced gas. The term of the authorization is for nine years which began on November 1, 1989, and ends October 31, 1998.

On April 10, 1995, NPMI informed the Department of Energy that all of its gas marketing assets were transferred to Northridge Gas Marketing, Inc. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization granted to NPMI by Order No. 349 is amended to substitute Northridge Gas Marketing,

Inc. for Northridge Petroleum Marketing, Inc. as the importer and exporter of natural gas.
