ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1014-A

---

On December 16, 1994, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Continental Energy Marketing Ltd. (Continental), in DOE/FE Order No. 1014 (Order 1014), 1 FE 71,066, to export up to 75 Bcf of natural gas from the United States to Canada over a period of two years beginning on the date of the first export delivery. Deliveries began on June 1, 1995, and end May 31, 1997. Continental recently changed its name to PanEnergy Marketing (PanEnergy) and, on April 24, 1996, requested that DOE terminate its export authorization. PanEnergy, a division of PanEnergy Services Canada Ltd., indicated imports and exports would be conducted under authority held by its U.S. company and therefore the authorization granted by Order 1014 would be no longer needed.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas originally issued to

PanEnergy s predecessor, Continental Energy Marketing Ltd., in  
Order 1014, is hereby vacated.
