ORDER TRANSFERRING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1093-A

On October 17, 1995, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Williams Energy Systems Company (WES) in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 1093 (Order 1093) to import up to 730 Bcf of natural gas from Canada and export up to 730 Bcf of natural gas to Canada.¹ The term of the authorization is for a period of two years beginning on the date of the first import or export delivery, whichever occurs first. Neither imports nor exports have commenced under this order.

On April 10, 1996, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that WES' parent firm, The Williams Companies, Inc., and Panhandle Eastern Corporation formed a new limited liability company named Altra Streamline, L.L.C. As a result of the formation of the new limited liability company, WES requests that the authorization granted in Order 1093 be transferred to Altra Streamline, L.L.C. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the

Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization granted in Order

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1093 is transferred from Williams Energy Systems Company to Altra Streamline, L.L.C., effective on the date of this Order. Altra Streamline, L.L.C. shall be bound by all terms and conditions set forth in Order 1093.
