ORDER AMENDING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1119-A

In DOE/FE Order No. 1119 (Order 1119), issued November 13, 1995, the Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy, under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA), authorized Meridian Oil Trading Inc. (Meridian) to export up to 100 Bcf of natural gas, including liquefied natural gas (LNG), to Mexico (see 1 FE

71,199). The term of the authorization is for two years beginning on the date of first export.

On October 31, 1996, Burlington Resources Trading Inc. filed an application to amend Order 1119 to reflect a name change resulting from an amendment to Meridian's Certificate of Incorporation, effective July 11, 1996. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the NGA, Order 1119 is amended to substitute Burlington Resources Trading Inc. for Meridian Oil Trading Inc. as the exporter of the natural gas and LNG.
