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ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1142-A

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On January 11, 1996, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Coral Energy Resources, L.P. (Coral) in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 1142 (Order 1142) to import a combined total of up to 730 Bcf of natural gas, including liquefied natural gas (LNG), from Canada and Mexico. Also, Order 1142 authorized Coral to export a combined total of up to 730 Bcf of natural gas, including LNG, to Canada and Mexico. The term of the authorization is for a period of two years beginning on the date of the first import or export delivery, whichever occurs first. Deliveries of natural gas to Mexico under Order 1142 began on July 27, 1996.

On October 22, 1996, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that Coral changed its name to Coral Energy, L.P., effective June 3, 1996. Therefore, Coral requests that the authorization granted in Order 1142 be amended to reflect this

change. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization granted in Order 1142 is

amended to substitute Coral Energy, L.P. for Coral Energy Resources, L.P. as the importer and exporter of natural gas. All terms and conditions in Order 1142 remain in full force and effect.
