ORDER TRANSFERRING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 480-A

On February 20, 1991, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to NMU Gas Purchasing, Inc. (NMU) in DOE/FE Order No. 480 (Order 480) to import up to 110 Bcf and export up to 110 Bcf of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on the date of the first import or export.¹ Deliveries of natural gas have not yet begun under this authorization.

On July 2, 1996, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that NMU, a wholly-owned subsidiary of UtiliCorp United Inc. (UtiliCorp), wishes to assign the blanket authorization to UtiliCorp.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization granted in Order 480 is

transferred from NMU Gas Purchasing, Inc. to UtiliCorp United

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Inc., effective on the date of this Order. All terms and conditions in Order 480 remain in full force and effect.
