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ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION  
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS  
AND LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 628-A

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On June 5, 1992, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to ENERGY International Marketing Corporation (EIMC) in DOE/FE Order NO. 628 (Order 628) to import and export up to a combined total of 200 Bcf of natural gas, including liquefied natural gas, from and to any foreign country.<sup>1/</sup> The term of the authorization is for a period of two years beginning on the date of the first import or export delivery, whichever occurs first. Deliveries of natural gas under Order 628 have not begun.

On July 15, 1996, as supplemented August 9, 1996, EIMC notified the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE that EIMC was to be "closed" and requested that Order 628 be transferred to EIMC's affiliate, ENERGY International Corporation. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization granted in Order 628 is amended to substitute

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Marketing Corporation as the importer and exporter of record.  
All terms and conditions in Order 628 remain in full force and  
effect.
