ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1019-A

On January 13, 1995, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Koch Gas Services Company (KGS) in DOE/FE Order No. 1019 (Order 1019) to import and export up to a combined total of 100 Bcf of natural gas from and to Mexico over a two-year term beginning on the date of the first import or export.¹ Deliveries of natural gas have not yet begun under this authorization.

On January 10, 1997, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that KGS changed its name to Koch Energy Trading, Inc. (KET) August 26, 1996. Effective January 1, 1997, KET merged into Koch Power Services, Inc. and the new entity's name was changed to KET. KET is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Koch Industries, Inc. KET requests that the authorization be amended

to reflect the name change.

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Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import/export authorization granted in Order 1019 is amended to substitute Koch Energy Trading, Inc. For Koch Gas Services Company as the importer and exporter of the natural gas. All terms and conditions in Order 1019 remain in full force and effect.
