AMENDING ORDER TO VACATE LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 425-B

Indeck-Yerkes Limited Partnership (Indeck-Yerkes) is currently authorized in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 425 (Order 425)⁽¹⁾ to import from Indeck Gas Supply Corporation up to 4.5 Bcf of Canadian natural gas per year over a term of 15 years beginning November 1, 1990.⁽²⁾ In an application filed August 24, 1998, Indeck-Yerkes requested the Department of Energy rescind its authorization.

Indeck-Yerkes owns and operates a non-utility generating facility and sells its power output to Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (NMPC). As the result of the implementation of a "Master Restructuring Agreement," effective June 30, 1998, between NMPC and certain non-utility generators, including Indeck-Yerkes, Indeck-Yerkes has entered into a new ten-year term power sales arrangement with NMPC at market sensitive prices. Due to this change in the nature of its contractual relationship with NMPC, Indeck-Yerkes has also entered into agreements to terminate its long-term gas supply contracts with Canadian producers. Future purchases of Canadian natural gas will be made in spot and short-term open market transactions with various Canadian suppliers. (3)

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 425 is amended to vacate the authorization granted to Indeck-Yerkes Limited Partnership to import natural gas. Issued in Washington, D.C., on September 10, 1998.
