Dear Mr. Lo Baugh:

The Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) is in receipt of the letter you submitted to DOE/FE on May 26, 2016 regarding Docket No. 12-05-LNG, Gulf Coast LNG Export, LLC. In the letter, you requested that Gulf Coast LNG Export's previous authorization (DOE/FE Order No. 3163) for exports to countries with free trade agreements (FTA) be vacated and the pending application for exports to countries that do not have a free agreement be withdrawn.

DOE/FE issued order 3163-A, Order Granting Request to Vacate Long-Term, Multi-Contract Authorization to Export LNG by Vessel to Free Trade Agreement Nations on June 27, 2016. This letter serves as acknowledgement that, pursuant to DOE regulations (10 C.F.R. 590.204(c)), the request to withdraw the pending application for exports to non-FTA countries took effect on June 27, 2016.
