ORDER AMENDING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 428-A


On September 29, 1990, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted Elizabethtown Gas Company (Elizabethtown) long-term authority to import up to 10,000 Mcf per day of natural gas from Canada, beginning on the date of first delivery. Deliveries of natural gas began on November 1, 1992.^{1/}

On May 12, 2004, Elizabethtown informed FE that it was merged as a corporate entity into NUI Corporation effective as of July 27, 1993. The organizational structure of Elizabethtown remains the same but the name is changed to NUI Utilities, Inc.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, DOE/FE Order No. 428 (Order 428) is amended to substitute NUI Utilities, Inc. as the importer of natural gas, effective the date of this Order. All terms and conditions in Order 428 remain in full force and effect.
