ORDER VACATING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1201-A

On September 18, 1996, the Department of Energy's (DOE) Office of Fossil Energy (FE) issued DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 1201¹/ (Order 1201) in Docket No. 96-50-NG, authorizing Coastal Gas Marketing Company (Coastal) to import up to 18.1 thousand cubic feet per day of Canadian natural gas over an 11-year term. In a letter dated May 25, 2005, DOE was notified that Duke Energy Marketing America, LLC (DEMA) had acquired Coastal and all of its assets and has no further use for the import authority. DEMA requests that DOE vacate Order 1201.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the long-term authorization granted by Order 1201, is hereby vacated.
