ORDER VACATING AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1938-A

FE DOCKET NO. 04-06-NG

On February 6, 2004, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 1938½/ (Order 1938) in Docket No. 04-06-NG granting Chevron U.S.A. Inc. (Chevron) authority to export up to 55 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas to Canada. On May 27, 2005, Chevron requested that the DOE terminate its blanket export authorization effective July 1, 2005.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 1938 authorizing the export of natural gas from Canada, is hereby vacated.
