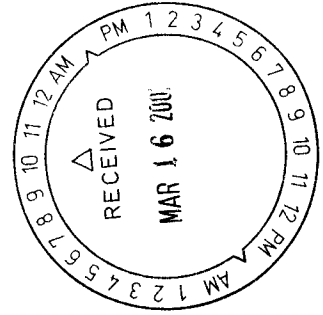

ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS
FROM AND TO CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2298-A

On November 22, 2006, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to WPS Energy Services of Canada Corp. (WPS Energy Canada) in DOE/FE Order No. 2298 (Order 2298) (2 FE ¶71,383) to import and export up to a combined total of 100 billion cubic feet of natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on November 1, 2006, and extending through October 31, 2008.

On February 21, 2007, DOE was notified that WPS Energy Canada changed its name to Integrys Energy Services of Canada Corp., effective February 21, 2007, and as a result, no longer needs the current authorization. WPS Energy Canada has requested that DOE vacate Order 2298, effective February 21, 2007.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas granted to WPS Energy Canada in Order 2298 is hereby vacated, effective February 21, 2007.
