ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS FROM AND TO
CANADA


DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2249-A

On August 28, 2006, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Seminole Canada Gas Company in DOE/FE Order No. 2249 (Order 2249) (2 FE ¶71,337) to import and export natural gas from and to Canada over a two-year term beginning on March 23, 2006, and extending through March 22, 2008.

On January 17, 2008, DOE was notified that Seminole Canada Gas Company had changed its name to SemCanada Energy (SemCanada), effective January 15, 2007, and was submitting a new application for similar blanket authorization to be issued in its new name. Therefore, SemCanada requested that DOE vacate Order 2249, to be effective as of the date of the new authorization.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas from and to Canada in Order 2249 is hereby vacated, effective January 29, 2008.
