ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2583-A

On November 10, 2008, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to International Paper Company (IPC) in DOE/FE Order No. 2583 (Order 2583) to import up to 1.5 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on November 10, 2008, and extending through November 9, 2010.

On May 24, 2010, IPC requested that DOE vacate Order 2583, effective May 24, 2010. IPC sold their Canadian natural gas pipeline capacity and no longer imports natural gas from Canada.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas granted to IPC in Order 2583 is hereby vacated, effective May 24, 2010.
