Liquefied Natural Gas to Non-Free Trade Countries**

Dear Mr. Anderson:

On August 31, 2012, Cheniere Marketing, LLC (“CMI”), filed an application for long-term, multi-contract authorization to engage in exports of domestically produced liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) in an amount up to 782 million MMBtu per year, which is equivalent to approximately 767 billion standard cubic feet of natural gas per year, for a 22-year term. CMI seeks authorization to export LNG to any country with which the U.S. does not now or in the future have a Free Trade Agreement requiring the national treatment for trade in natural gas and LNG that has, or in the future develops, the capacity to import LNG and with which trade is not prohibited by U.S. law or policy. CMI is requesting this authorization in order to act on its own behalf and in order to act on behalf of or as agent for third parties.
