Application for Long-Term, Multi-Contract Authorization to Export Liquefied Natural Gas to Non-Free Trade Agreement Countries

## Dear Mr. Anderson:

On October 5, 2012, Excelerate Liquefaction Solutions I, LLC ("ELS") submitted an application ("Application") to the Department of Energy ("DOE") for long-term, multicontract authorization to engage in exports of domestically produced liquefied natural gas ("LNG") in an amount up to 10 million metric tons per year for a 20-year term. ELS hereby requests to place that proceeding in abeyance until April 1, 2015.

Subsidiaries of ELS<sup>1</sup> filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") on February 6, 2014, seeking authorization for proposed LNG export facilities under Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act and a certificate of public convenience and necessity for a feeder gas pipeline under Section 7 of the Natural Gas Act (the "Project").

Recent global economic conditions—including, among other things, a steep decrease in the price of oil—have created uncertainty regarding the economics of the Project. In light of these changes, ELS has conducted a strategic reconsideration of the economic value of the Project and yesterday requested to place the Project proceedings at the Commission on hold.

Similarly, ELS requests to place the above-captioned proceeding in abeyance until April 1, 2015. Granting this request would help to prevent the unnecessary expenditure of
