LNG Development Company, LLC (d/b/a Oregon LNG) and Oregon Pipeline Company, LLC have filed to withdraw their applications pending before the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission for authorization to site, construct and operate a bi-directional LNG terminal and associated pipeline facilities in the state of Oregon ("Oregon LNG Project"). Consequently, through this letter Oregon LNG seeks to vacate DOE/FE Order No. 3100, issued by the Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy ("DOE/FE") in FE Docket No. 12-48-LNG, granting Oregon LNG long-term authorization to engage in exports of up to 9.6 million metric tons per annum of liquefied natural gas ("LNG") to Free Trade Agreement ("FTA") nations from the Oregon LNG Project.

Additionally, Oregon LNG seeks to withdraw its application for authorization to engage in exports of up to 9.6 million metric tons per annum of LNG to Non-FTA nations pending in FE Docket No. 12-77-LNG (the "Non-FTA Application"). DOE/FE issued Order No. 3465 conditionally granting the Non-FTA Application on July 31, 2014, which Oregon LNG seeks to vacate as well.

Oregon LNG would like to thank the DOE/FE staff for its diligent work on these proceedings.
