ORDER GRANTING
REHEARING FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION

JULY 10, 2015

On May 12, 2015, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy (DOE/FE), issued a final opinion and order to Cheniere Marketing, LLC and Corpus Christi Liquefaction, LLC, captioned DOE/FE Order No. 3638, authorizing the export of liquefied natural gas (LNG) by vessel from the proposed Corpus Christi Liquefaction Project located near Corpus Christi, Texas, to nations with which the United States has not entered into a free trade agreement (FTA) providing for national treatment for trade in natural gas (non-FTA nations).¹ Subsequently, on June 11, 2015, intervenor-protestor Sierra Club submitted a Request for Rehearing of DOE/FE Order No. 3638.

In order to afford additional time for consideration of the matters raised in Sierra Club's Request for Rehearing, rehearing is hereby granted for the limited purpose of further consideration. Accordingly, Sierra Club's Request for Rehearing will not be deemed denied by operation of law pursuant to DOE regulations. 10 C.F.R. § 590.504.
