A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE MAGNOLIA LNG, LLC APPLICATION WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY'S OFFICE OF FOSSIL ENERGY (DOE-FE), DOCKET 13-132-LNG.

WHEREAS, Magnolia LNG, LLC is requesting a long-term, multi-contract authorization to export liquefied natural gas (LNG) produced from domestic sources by vessel from the proposed Magnolia LNG Terminal to be located in Calcasieu Parish in Southwest Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that if the application is approved by DOE-FE, that Magnolia LNG would receive authorization to export LNG by vessel to non-free trade agreement (Non-FTA) countries for a twenty-five (25) year term; and

WHEREAS, the proposed \$3.5 billion Magnolia LNG Project, to be located on approximately 115 acres on the Calcasieu Ship Channel, will receive natural gas by way of an existing pipeline, treat, liquefy and store the LNG for eventual offloading into LNG carriers for overseas exportation or for domestic distribution and consumption; and

WHEREAS, numerous public meetings have been held in the community over the past year to educate public officials and private citizens about the proposed facility's operations and its proprietary liquefaction technology which is anticipated to result in significantly less emissions than traditional liquefaction processes, reducing the operation's environmental impact in the Southwest Louisiana region; and

WHEREAS, Magnolia LNG's Project is expected to provide approximately 1,000 construction jobs and over 70 permanent jobs to this community, which will positively impact economic growth in Calcasieu Parish and all of Southwest Louisiana.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE POLICE JURY OF CALCASIEU PARISH, LOUISIANA, convened in Regular Session on the 17th day of April, 2014, that it does hereby express its support of Magnolia LNG's application with the DOE-FE (Docket 13-132-LNG) for authorization to export LNG.

BE IF FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the United States Department of Energy's (FE-34) Office of Oil and Gas Global Security and Supply, Office of Fossil Energy for consideration in this matter.
