ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO  
IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS  
FROM AND TO CANADA AND MEXICO

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2940-A

On April 5, 2011, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Louis Dreyfus Energy Services L.P. (LDES) in DOE/FE Order No. 2940 (Order 2940) to import and export up to a combined total of 1,000 Billion Cubic Feet of natural gas from and to Canada and Mexico over a two-year term beginning on April 5, 2011, and extending through April 4, 2013.

On February 26, 2013, LDES notified DOE that it changed its name to Castleton Commodities Merchant Trading L.P on January 1, 2013. As a result, LDES requests that DOE vacate Order 2940, effective immediately.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas granted to LDES in Order 2940 is hereby vacated, effective the date of this Order.
