Emera CNG, LLC ("Emera") hereby provides the clarifications requested in your April 24, 2014 ("Letter") concerning Emera's Application for Long-Term Authorization to Export Compressed Natural Gas filed on November 20, 2013 in the above captioned ("Application").

First, the Letter requests that Emera confirm that the Application is a request to export CNG by waterborne vessel as opposed to export by truck alone. Emera confirms that all exports from the Facility will be by waterborne vessel. Emera will not export CNG from the Facility by truck alone.

Second, the Letter states that your office will consider the source and supply of CNG to be only the Facility and will not authorize exports of CNG from other facilities. The Letter requests that Emera confirm its agreement with this understanding of the Application. Emera confirms its agreement that the Facility will be the only source and supply of CNG to be exported. As purchases of CNG from other facilities during maintenance periods for the Facility will be short-term (*i.e.*, pursuant to contracts of less than two years in duration), Emera intends to file an application for blanket authorization to export CNG from other facilities to be identified in such application.
