Dear U.S. Department of Energy and President Obama,

As a new Oregon resident I am deeply concerned for the future of our state, and our country on this matter. The negative impacts of exporting Natural Gas are quite serious on both an environmental/health level and the economic level for the whole country.

Please consider the total negative effects of LNG Export on public health (i.e. poisoned wells from fracking, pollution, risk of sudden-death by pipeline explosion), the economy (i.e. domestic gas prices actually rising, pipeline easements expanding, eminent-domain land-seizures), and the environment (i.e. poisoned wells from fracking, marine/wetland habitat erased, deforesting the pipeline route, disturbing sensitive waterways, increased air-pollution, greenhouse gasses, heavy-load trucks destroying roads, a power-plant and tanker in a tsunami-induction zone).
