## Dear President Obama:

Liquefied Natural Gas gives us a fantastic opportunity here in the U.S.A. I will close by urging you to take the steps necessary to expedite the approval process for the export of LNG. Building the energy infrastructure necessary to allow market-based exports of liquefied natural gas will not only add stability to the energy production cycle in our region, it will create

more American jobs, help reverse economic downturns, and continue reviving areas like ours that have had declining industries in recent decades like coal and steel. Thank you for your time and attention to this important matter and congratulations on your recent re-election.
